Mrs. Emma V. Schramm, 79, died at her residence at 124 Fairview at approximately 5 p.m. Monday.

Born in Humansville, Mo., Dec. 16, 1892, she moved with her parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. C. B. Warner, to Kay County as a child, locating on a farm southeast of Newkirk. She graduated from Newkirk High School.

She was married to Mr. John Schramm in Joplin, Mo., and they made their home in Newkirk until 1969 when they moved to Ponca City. For a period of 20 years, Mrs. Schramm worked in the county assessor's office at Newkirk, retiring as chief clerk.

Survivors included her husband, John, of the home; one sister, Mrs. Purl Wiggins, Coral Gables, Fla., and a niece, Mrs. Billie (Betty) Lou Teas, Baltimore, Md.
